Writing



The main writing genres:

Fiction
Writing a defeat the monster story – The 3 Little Pigs.

Non-Fiction
Diary

The key skills we will cover:

Any time we write we will be focusing on:


- Writing in full sentences using full stops and capital letters
- key word spellings – **little, house, blow, wolf**
- Key Words vocabulary -unfortunately, first, third, second, creeping, blazing, chimney, boiling, scary, clumsy.
- Making our sentences more interesting by using adjectives and adverbs.

In our fiction writing we will focus on character descriptions. We will add detail to these by:

- Adding adjectives to add interest for their reader
- Using adverbs and similes to describe things

In our Non-fiction we will focus on sequencing (ordering) texts and writing in the past tense.



The key skills we will cover:

This term we will be focussing on vocabulary and discussing words and phrases that excite us. We will be using dictionaries to look up new words, using a thesaurus to find alternative words and 'magpieing' words and phrases to use in our own writing.



Maths

The main areas of Maths we will learn about:

Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

Money

Multiplication.

The key skills and learning will we focus on:

Place Value

- Count objects to 100 and read and write numbers in numerals and words.
- Represent numbers to 100.
- Partition numbers using the part, part whole method.
- Use a place value chart.
- Compare objects and numbers.
- Order objects and numbers
- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's
- Count in 3's.

Addition and subtraction

- Adding and subtracting bonds to 20.
- Compare number sentences.
- Related facts. Eg $3 + 7 = 10$ so $7 + 3 = 10$
- Adding and subtracting 2 digit and one digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting 2 digit and two digit numbers.
- Number bonds to 100
- Adding three 1 digit numbers.

Money

- Count money – pence and pounds
- Select money for making different amounts.
- Make the same amounts using different coins.
- Find the total of amounts.
- Find how to give change.

Multiplication

- Recognise, make and add equal groups.
- Multiply using the x symbol.
- Draw and recognise arrays.
- Multiplying 2's, 5's and 10's times table.
