


Timeline

Historical Skills And Enquiry

Historical Enquiry: Use documents, printed sources, the internet, databases, pictures, photographs, music, artefacts, historical buildings, visits to museums and galleries as evidence about the past. Ask questions and find out answers about the past

Knowledge and understanding: Use evidence to describe the culture and leisure activities from the past. Use evidence to describe the clothes, way of life and actions of people in the past. Use evidence to describe buildings and their uses of people from the past

Chronological understanding: Understand that a timeline can be divided into **BC (Before Christ)** and **AD (Anno Domini)**. Use a timeline to place historical events in chronological order. Describe dates of and order significant events from the period studied.



Vocabulary

Afterlife	The place where egyptians believed they would go after they died
Akhet	The season of the year the Nile river flooded
dynasty	A period of rule when a series of pharaohs all came from the same family
pharaoh	The ruler of all of ancient Egypt
hieroglyphics	A type of writing that uses both symbols and pictures
Mummification	The process of preserving a body after death in preparation for the afterlife
Canopic jars	Special jars that held the organs of a mummy
sarcophagus	A large stone box that held a mummy's coffin

- The afterlife was important to the Egyptians
- The pyramid of Khufu at Giza is the largest
- The Egyptian alphabet had more than 700 hieroglyphics
- Ancient Egyptians believed in more than 2000 deities
