### Important Facts

- The Bible is split into two parts – The Old and The New testament
- The Creation story – God created the world in 6 days and on the 7<sup>th</sup> he rested
- The story of Adam and Eve – God created Adam and Eve and asked Adam to look after the world
- Harvest is the time of year where Christians say thank you to God for providing them with food
- 3 parables – The Lost Sheep, The Lost Coin, The Lost Son: stories told by Jesus to teach people that is important to own up and say thank you
- Christians pray to say thank you to God, that they love God and to say they are sorry
- Prayer can happen at any time and anywhere.
