Wellesley Park Coronation Colour Run - Wednesday 28th June 2023

We would like to invite you to join us for our re-scheduled afternoon of celebratory fun to mark the Coronation of King Charles III.

In order to help you with planning ahead for this day, I would like to share the following details with you:

Things to remember please:

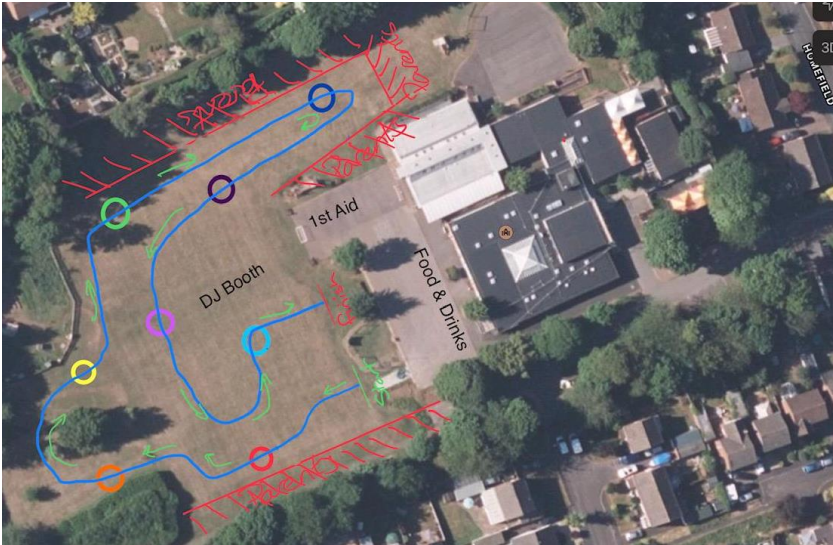
- ❖ Please ensure that your child has a change of clothes ready for the colour run in the afternoon.
- ❖ Please bring a picnic blanket and picnic lunch
- ❖ **Any hot meals already booked for Wednesday 28th June on ParentPay will be cancelled and there will be an option to order a school packed lunch instead if you wish to. Please do this by the end of day on Thursday 22nd June.** Please do not forget to do this if you would like a packed lunch provided by the caterers. The deadline for all other lunch orders that week will remain the end of the day on Tuesday 20th June.
- ❖ You will need to collect your child from their classroom door, for 12:15pm, in order for them to join you for their picnic lunch. **If you are unable to attend yourself and you would like your child to sit with another family – then please let your child's class teacher know.**
- ❖ If the weather is hot – please ensure that your child has a sun hat, sun cream is applied and a refillable water bottle.

Please note: In order to ensure the safety and security of all pupils, no child will be able to leave school site.

Timings for the Colour Run shared picnic lunch and Colour-Run:

- **12:00pm** End of KS2 Sports Day – children to return to class. Parents to find a picnic spot on the KS2 field. Main gates (next to Dukes) will be opened for KS1 parents to join for lunch and the colour run. Please arrive promptly as we will not be able to facilitate late entry.
- **12:15pm** - Gates will be closed.
Visitors can then head to the back of the school and onto our main KS2 playground, where the PTA will be selling an abundance of non-alcoholic beverages and a plethora of yummy cakes!
- **12:15pm** Whole school picnic lunch
- **12:50pm** Pupils will return to class to pack away lunch boxes, use toilets and change into colour run appropriate clothes.
- **1.15pm** Pupils and staff will assemble on the KS2 playground

- **1.30pm** – Welcome speech by Mrs Wilkins – Headteacher
- **1.35pm** – Whole school sing along
- **1:45pm** – Parents will be asked to move to the outside of the colour run track area (see diagram) whilst pupils will move to the inside field area - Red hash lines indicate parent areas:

 Pupils will be seated in year groups along the inner-field area, where it says 'DJ booth'

- **1.50pm** the colour run will begin. Throughout the afternoon, photos will be taken and shared on our school website / school Facebook and newspaper and the usual permissions already given will be applied. **However**, if your child usually has 'no permission' for these kinds of photos but you *would* like them to be included for this special event, then please do let your child's class teacher know.
- Once all children have participated, **there will be a 'Parent / Carer Colour run – which you are all welcome to join in with!**
- **2.50pm** all pupils and staff will gather again on the KS2 playground; Mrs Wilkins will then share a few words to close the event
- **At the end of the school day**, children will return to their classrooms to collect their belongings and the usual end of day procedures will apply.
 You will be able to purchase drinks / cakes again at the end of the school day. The PTA has also kindly organised an ice-cream van to be on site for you to purchase lollies/ice-creams.
- **3.30pm** The school gates will be closed to allow for the playground / field to be cleared.

As always, these events can't happen without lots of understanding, help and support. If you feel that whilst watching, you could be a 'powder-thrower' then please do let someone from our PTA know! We are rather short on volunteers to help out, at this point in time – especially with all of the setting up to organise / food and drinks to sell etc. ANY help would be so appreciated and valued by us all.
